Junior spring semester: Anglia, Queen's Univ (Ireland)

Take equivalent of MRT 373 Electronic Music and 374 Digital Audio and standard music courses: applied lesson, ensemble.

Senior spring semester: New Zealand, Anglia, Ireland

MRT is designed so that all academic requirements can be completed by end of fall semester senior year. Spring semester can be used for full-time internship or study abroad if desired. No MRT courses would be required, but standard music courses must be taken: applied lesson, ensemble. Internship should be taken summer before or after senior year.
